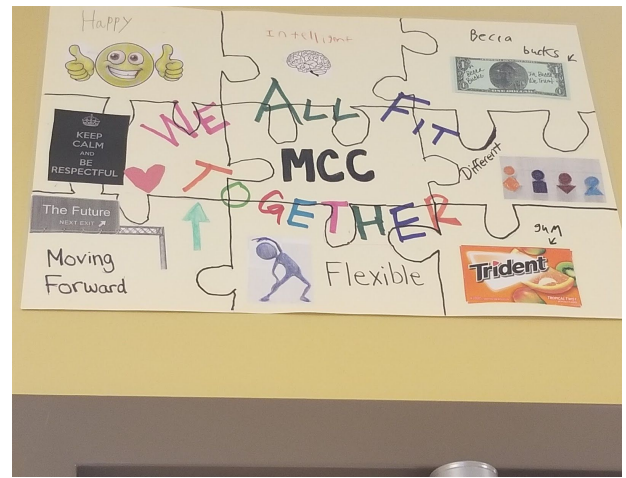
New podcast from Fort Zumwalt Schools
